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The predecessor of National Taiwan University was the Taihoku Imperial University during the period of Japanese Occupation.

Founded in 1928 (the 17th year of the Republic of China), the first President was Shindevra Tan.

In 1945 the Nationalist government won the war of resistance against Japan, so on November the 15th the university underwent a retrocession to Chinese sovereignty.

The nationalist government assumed administ ration, reorganized the University, & renamed it "National Taiwan University."

Spurred with "Aim for Top University Plan" funding, NTU achieved a rapid acceleration & transformation: in world university rankings, NTU's jumped in Shanghai Jiaotong University's ranking of 183rd place in the world in 2005 to 127th place in 2010.

NTU placed 94th in the QS World University Rankings in 2010 and it reached the 81st to 90th-spot bracket in the Times Higher Education's World University Rankings for 2011.

In the globally leading microwave journal—IEEE Microwave Theory & Technology (T-MTT), NTU was the No.1 among all academic and research institutions in the world for three consecutive years (from 2006 to 2008) in terms of the number of papers published & the number of papers cited.



In addition, our SoC IC design team has the greatest number of theses published in the ISSCC, the so-called "Olympiad of the Chip World" for five consecutive years.

Compared with the top universities of the world, we have surpassed MIT, Stanford University, UC Berkeley, & UCLA.





As for our multi-media team, in the most noted annual contest—Knowledge Discovery & Data Mining Competition (KDDCUP), NTU beat 200 participating teams & won the top prize in 2008 with an automatic breast cancer imaging technology whose accuracy rate approached 90%; and, in 2009, NTU won the 3rd place among 400 participating teams by being able to correctly forecast customer behavior.

NTU Research Center for Medical Excellence discovered the biological markers related to gastric cancer & duodenal ulcer & the new virulence factors associated with helicobacter pylori.

It also successfully established the knockout mice technology & its core facilities.



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So far the Center has completed more than 50 cases to construct knockout mice strains.

The Center had published more than 200 papers in top notch international journals such as *Nature & Cell biology*.

Its research accomplishment is very outstanding.

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vationa Taiwan University The major achievements of NTU Neurobiology & Cognitive **Science Center include:**

- (1) Discovered that rational thinking & intuitive thinking of human beings activates different regions of the human brain. The Center published 12 neuro-imaging papers in top journals and had many patent inventions in MRI technologies.
- (2) The schizophrenia research team found that there were nine pathogenic SNPs distributed over four pathogenic genes.
- (3) Discovered the pathogenic genes in schizophrenia, the so-called Genetic risk dosage phenomenon.

NTU prides itself on academic excellence & often reflects upon itself according to international standards.

It actively participates in international exchanges, & seeks to expand its relations with the top academic institutions in the world.

Through faculty/student exchange programs, cooperative research projects, participating in international activities, etc., NTU enables its faculty & students to march into the wider world, & become truly "cosmopolitan".

Additionally, through the offering of dual degrees with foreign universities, the provision of scholarships & assistantships, & a thoughtful foreign student care-taking & counseling system, we work to "internationalize" our instructional environment.

By increasing the number of courses taught in English & cooperation with Academic Sinica to offer curricula for international graduate students, we try to increase the internationalization of our graduate programs.



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So far, we attracted over 1700 foreign students to NTU to pursue their graduate studies. As of July, 2010, NTU had established academic exchange programs with 350 universities, of which 380 were university level contracts, & 380 were college level contracts.

The total number of agreements thus had reached 760, & the universities represented Europe, America, Asia, Africa, & Oceania.

The fruits of our efforts can only be described as plentiful.
